Active Ingredients:

Sodium chloride 5%

Purpose:

Hypertonicity agent

Inactive ingredient:

Boric acid, Hypromellose, Propylene glycol, Water for Injection, sodium borate. Sodium hydroxide / hydrochloric acid may be added to adjust pH. Preservative Added: Phenyl Mercuric Nitrate 0.001% w/v

Uses:

Temporary relieve of corneal edema

Warnings:

Do not use

- Except under the advice and supervision of a doctor
- If solution changes color or becomes cloudy

When using this product

- It may cause temporary burning and irritation
- Do not touch tip of container to any surface to avoid contamination
- Replace cap after use.

Stop use and ask a doctor if

- Condition worsens or persists for more than 72 hours
- You experience eye pain, changes in vision, continued redness or irritation of the eye

Directions:

Instill 1 or 2 drops in the affected eye(s) every 3 or 4 hours, or as directed by a Physician.

Storage and handling instructions:

Keep in a cool place. Use the solution within one month after opening the container. Do not touch the tip of the container to any surface. Replace cap after using.

HYPERSENZ is a sterile solution supplied in opaque plastic dropper bottle with a cap, Containing 10 mL of the solution.

Directions for use :



Turn the tamper proof cap anti-clockwise to break the seal.



Remove the cap, dispense drops with gentle pressure.

Replace the cap immediately after every use.
